Congratulations! Your company is the owner, designer, or general contractor of a project that has been named project of the year or won an award of merit in *Midwest Construction* Magazine's recent "Best of 2009" competition.

This year's competition saw 128 projects entered in 20 categories that ranged from Interior Design / Tenant Buildout to Civil / Public Works. The entries were sorted into categories so judges could compare similar projects.

All of the entries in each category were judged by a panel of independent experts who considered a variety of key criteria, such as innovation, safety, contribution to the community or industry, unique or difficult challenges overcome, quality, and other factors.

Outstanding projects were given an award of merit. In nearly all categories, the most outstanding project was given a project-of-the-year award.
